

Housing in Chur

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FHGR does not have any own accommodation offerings, but the International Office would like to support foreign students by giving some non-binding hints. The most popular options for foreign students are:

1. **Shared accommodation** → sublet a room from another student and live in a shared accommodation; most rooms are at least partially furnished.
2. **Residential establishment** → rent a room in a residential establishment and live with other young people; it's common that meals are provided.
3. **Hotel apartments** → rent a fully furnished hotel room; mostly equipped with a small kitchen.
4. **Private apartments** → rent an own apartment; mostly not furnished.

Rental and share accommodation scam / fraud

Please be aware of cyber criminals advertising rooms or fake rental properties on the Internet.

- Be wary of too good to be true offers
- Inspect the property yourself or, if you can't, get someone else to inspect it (e.g. your buddy)
- Be wary of paying via money wire transfer. Wire transfer is often a sign of a scam because the money is difficult to recover
- Use your commonsense and be alert to inconsistencies in stories
